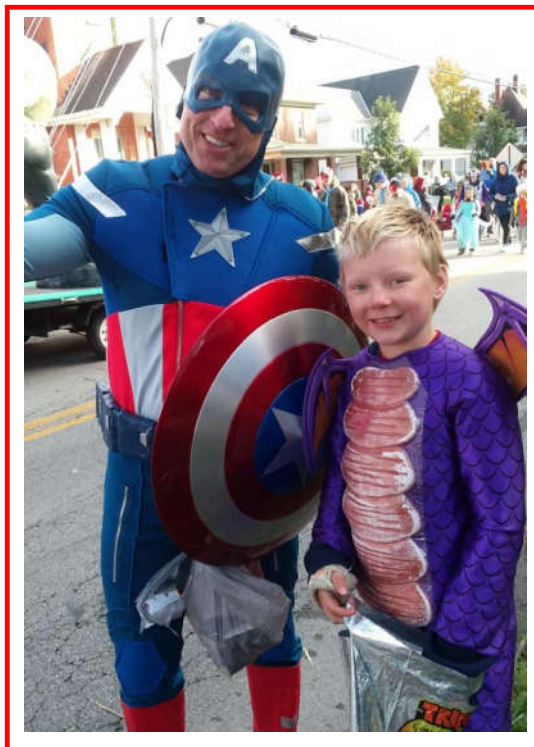

Election changes things

NOVEMBER 7, 2017, "There'll be some changes made" the song says. Such will be the case for Clyde voters on Tuesday in two or three races, depending if they live in Clyde or townships and thus school district..

CITY COUNCIL will have at least one new member elected to fill the seat left vacant by the untimely passing of Vice Mayor Kenneth Dick August 30. Former Councilmember Gary Beamer is filling the seat but not eligible for election. Seats held by incumbents Scott Black and Steven Keegan also are open. Four persons are on the ballot with Black and Keegan - Bobbi Baker Boyer, Bev Clark Henson, Paula Schrickel Renfro and Brent Stanley complete the ballot for THREE open four-year terms.

Boyer, an Ohio social worker, presently is completing a two-year assignment for the state, developing training programs to assist Children's Services social workers who often serve homes and families facing addiction and recovery, helping children living in these environments. She wrote the programs for Ohio workforce dealing with the Opiate crisis.

Renfro retired from Whirlpool. She is on the City Recreation Board, serving a term as chairwoman. The Rec Board is established by the Ohio Revised Code.

Stanley is Chairman of the Board of Zoning Appeals and offers administrator experience; familiarity with laws, ordinances, legislative issues and regulations.

BOARD OF EDUCATION will have one new member for the first time in 32 years with the retirement of **Nancy Pearce Greenslade**.

Trish Prunty and Michael Cleveland are finishing appointments for seats vacated in the last two years. The are joined by newcomers Crystal Henson and Mark Rosche to make FOUR competing for THREE open four-year terms.

The District includes Green Creek Township, part of Green Springs, parts of Ballville Township and extends into Bellevue and Seneca County.

Prunty has/had students in Clyde Schools. She is a college instructor.

Rosche is retired from Clyde Schools where he was an English teacher in McPherson Middle School and its predecessor Clyde Junior High School. He coaches, writes a blog where he features interviews with Clyde Alumni athletes and is most known as the Voice of the Fliers. Last week he was commentator for the Halloween Parade.
