THE FOOD WAGONS with all their wares.

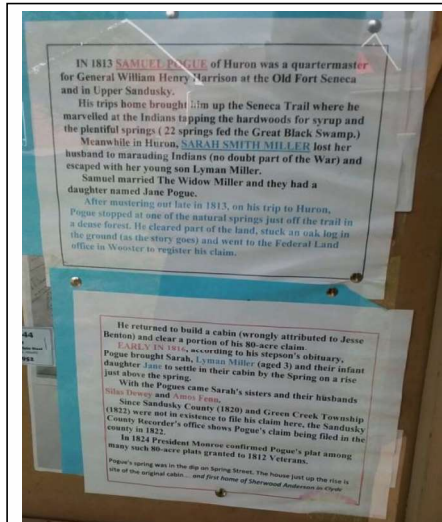


THE MIDTERMS

Tuesday October 9 is the FINAL DAY to register to vote or to change address if you moved since the last election or if you changed your name since the last election.

Wednesday October 10 is the FIRST DAY of absentee voting in the November 6 midterm elections. You may request an absentee ballot anytime in writing to the Board of Elections or vote in-person at the BOE after Oct. 10

CITY COUNCIL and the Sandusky County Parks Department recently discussed removing the six information boards that are part of the Northcoast Inland Buckeye Trail in Clyde - this kiosk and a two-sided board on Woodland.

Since 2012, The Sherwood Anderson Society has voluntarily kept four of the six boards updated with events, meal locations, directions to services (police shopping areas, restrooms, and bicycle services, etc.)

In 2016 we devoted one board permanently to the dates in the history of our area - Eight Flags Over Us - from 1534 and including 1816 when Samuel Pogue settled permanently. **That story from the board is on page one.**



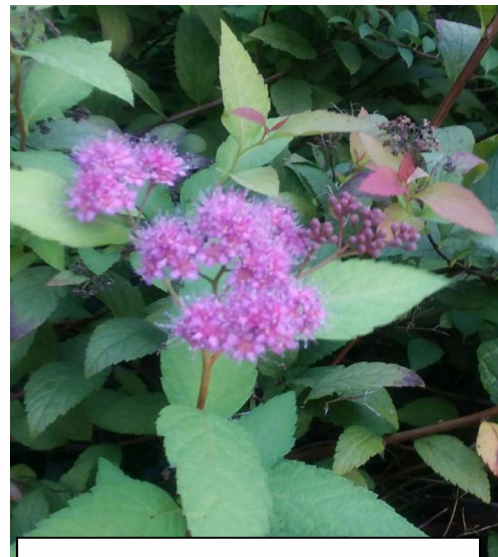

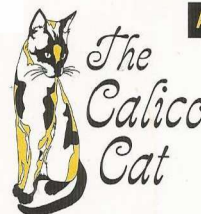
