1979 MUNICIPAL BUILDING opens after three years of debate over cashing water bonds, recall election, negative editorials in The Clyde Enterprise, and directive by Solicitor William Pearce to condemn and demolish the Haaser Block of buildings before it could be placed on the ballot.



160 years of history sandblasted to original surface. The Harkness Block was built in the middle of the west side of Main Street in 1859 by William Harkness and Lyman Miller, who was stepson of first permanent settler Samuel Pogue.

30 CL&P created by City and Whirlpool

SANDUSKY - Providence Care Center did not receive its 2019 Certificate of Compliance from the Ohio Department of Health until late April . Its 2018 Certificate expired January 1, 2019.

At issue were complaints about Food Preparation and allegations of abuse and neglect. ODOH officials worked with the Center to rectify the situations.
