'Immigrants' began 'gratitude' tradition

ADVENT. Sunday begins another GrAttitude season

After **BLACK FRIDAY** and **SHOP SMALL SATURDAY** comes the first most important Sunday of **ADVENT** - which anticipates the Birth of Jesus on Christmas Eve. The four **candles** represent the four weeks of **Advent**, and one candle is lit each Sunday. Three of the candles are purple, violet - a liturgical color that signifies a time of prayer, penance, and sacrifice. The first **candle**, which is purple, symbolizes hope. ... The third **candle** is pink and symbolizes joy. At Center is the Christ Candle lit Christmas Eve.
