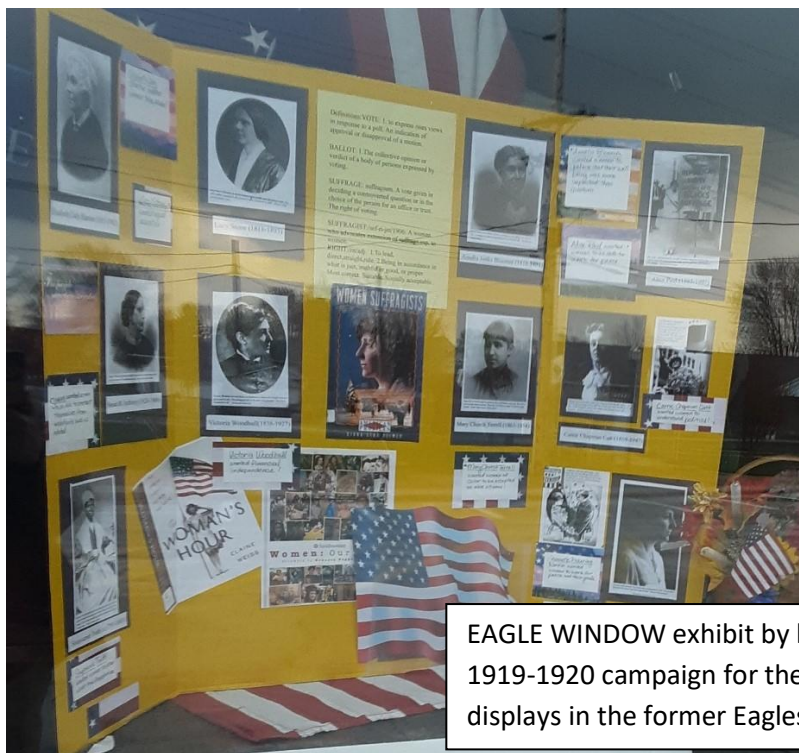

THE IMPORTANCE OF VOTING

November 2, 1920 - Hundreds of United States women voted for the **FIRST TIME** in a U.S. Presidential Election, choosing Ohio Republican William Harding over Ohio Democratic Gov. James Cox.

1918 Pandemic The four years leading up to the presidential election of 1920 had delivered a ghastly confluence of war, pestilence, unresrt and unemployment. As soon as World War I finished taking the lives of 100,000 Americans, a global influenza pandemic stole another 650,000 more.
